'B' 50/50

'B' Yellow. Medium route suitable 50's machines & clubman riders.

'C' White. Easy route for pre-war & rigid machines & gentleman riders.

Pre 65 Pre Unit & Twin, Unit & 2stroke, Rigid: Twinshock; Aircooled Mono; Over 50; Novice.

Signage at event:

Riders must adhere to all safety signs at the venue.

Entry to the Event:

Entry fees to be paid online prior to the event. Cash will not be accepted on the day of the event. Payment to be made via the ACU On-Line system.

Event Duration:

One day, no accommodation / camping etc.

Restriction on the number of Competitors:

Restricted to 90 competitors.

Youth participation at a Trials event:

Youths should be accompanied by one parent / legal guardian to help with overall Social Distancing. Should a rider fall, then the parent / legal guardian only should assist the rider.

Section Observers.

Observers will be at each sections. Riders and Observers should maintain social distancing. Riders will start the trial at a nominated section number as directed at the riders brief.

Signing On:

The competitor enters the event via the ACU On Line System and in doing so receives a riding number for the event on the day, when signing on with the trial secretary.

No One Day Licences will be issued.
