**Event Duration:**

One day, no accommodation / camping etc.

**Restriction on the number of Competitors:** 100**Spectators** welcome. **Catering van in attendance** (bank card payments accepted). Sorry **no toilets**.**Youth participation at a Trials event:**

Youths must be accompanied by one parent / legal guardian to help with overall Social Distancing. Should a rider fall, then the parent / legal guardian only should assist the rider. Participants under the age of 18 need a signed declaration of a parent or person with parental responsibility. Child Protection: The Secretary of the Meeting is the point of contact (NSC 6.14)

**Section Observers.**

Each section will be marked by an independent observer. Riders will start the trial at a nominated section number as directed at the riders brief on the day.

**Signing On:**

Riders must report to the Trial Secretary's Trailer where they will be signed in and given a riding number. Riders entering on the day must show their ACU licence or purchase a day license at £5.00 per rider.

**Litter and Waste.**

It is the responsibility of each rider / Official / member of the public to take their own litter / waste away with them.
